Kantha Embroidery

5 - 15 Places ONLY

What: Inspired by the traditions of Kantha quilts. Fragments of fancy work will be stitched to create a small panel or quilt.

A small sample will be worked first for an understanding of the stitchery method. This will be followed by the layering and stitching of your own piece using fragments and scraps that have special meaning for you. All stitching will be done 'in the hand'. No previous embroidery experience is necessary.
