The Brief

The Stanthorpe Art Gallery invites you to participate in the upcoming public program titled *Spoon, Spoon, Spoon*, on display from Friday 19th September – Tuesday 28th October 2008.

The gallery is seeking spoony work to be contributed to the installation during the course of the exhibition, growing each day as new entries are added. We pose the questions; what is the spoon? What is it for? What else can you do with it? How can you change the spoon to be more than a spoon?

Spoon, Spoon, Spoon coincides with these exhibitions:

1. *The Dying Darling*– a collaborative project by artist Michael Pospischil and photographer & environmentalist Sarah Moles presents the human face of the water reform process, in an exhibition of charcoal drawings.
2. *Vessels*- This exhibition by Stanthorpe artist Adrian Hobba features a collection of functional pieces made with traditional and modern materials using forging, cold forming, repousse and fabrication techniques. Sculptural works and artefact replicas will also expand on the concept of the vessel.
3. *Drinks & Dams*- Curated from the Shire’s permanent art collection, this exhibition of oil, acrylic and watercolour paintings aims at featuring water in our rural landscape.

We need your help! We’re inviting the young and old to go crazy decorating spoons, ladles and scoops to be included in a growing installation reflecting on the many uses of these kitchen ‘vessels’! Whether they’re made from metal, clay, wood or plastic, spoons come in so many shapes and sizes. You can sculpt or paint your spoon, stick things onto it or use a series of spoons to make your masterpiece, the choice is yours.
